About Haryana MSME Samvaad

India has potential to become an established economic power and in doing so MSMEs would play a vital role and contributing to the growth of economy in terms of industrial production, exports, employment, and entrepreneurial base. Haryana considered to be the largest Industrial, IT/ITES hubs of India with more than 1, 00,000 MSMEs units of a total investment exceeding Rs. 20,000 crores are generating employment for more than 10 lakh persons.

With the on-going pandemic situation, special emphasis being given to the development of MSME sector and their growth. The vision is to build Haryana as the competitive and most favoured investment destination. Haryana MSME sector also has to attract investment of over Rs 1 lakh crore and generate 5 lakh jobs in the state and to reach this target and lay the foundation of 'Aatmanirbhar Bharat' several measures and policy incentives such as the concession on land price, cluster development, enhancing market linkages and international collaboration, enhancing access to infrastructure and technology, regulatory simplification, infrastructure support and fiscal incentives are intended to provide a stimulus to the growth and development activity of MSME sector in the state and to promote entrepreneurship.

In the forthcoming times Haryana's MSMEs to have significant role for generating employment opportunities for youth at their doorstep in rural areas on the road to balanced regional development. After the small businesses shutters down during the lockdown phase across the country hit the sector particularly hard and facing the liquidity crunch to sustain and grow further. Most of the MSMEs rely on NBFCs and Micro Finance Institutions for their financial needs in the absence of access to the banking sector. A visible gap in the credit supply shortage to MSMEs is there in India and funding requirement has been largely unmet due to limited availability.

Haryana is one of the best places in the India with abundant underutilized land and resources for manufacturing and industrialization development projects with the state announcement of the robust and progressive New Enterprises and Employment Policy; In view of its immense



significance, the ASSOCHAM in partnership with Resurgent India is organizing Virtual Session on Haryana MSME SAMVAD -“Reinventing and Scaling up MSMEs in Haryana: Fostering a Robust Atmanirbhar State” on Friday, May 21, 2021. In the virtual session, experts will discuss and deliberate upon the various sources & latest trends of MSME financing, issues and new opportunities and will also talk about how state, central governments are stepping in to foster MSME financial resilience in the face of the COVID-19 pandemic.

Inaugural



MSME sector is the backbone of the modern-day economy which is under revival due to the pandemic and a strong pillar which can fulfil the dream of the Hon'ble Prime Minister to make India an economy of USD 5 Trillion.

As northern region of the country has strong potential to grow MSMEs, ASSOCHAM Northern region started an initiative called 'MSME Samvaad' to discuss the roadmap and present scenario of MSMEs in states like Haryana, Punjab, Himachal Pradesh and UT of Jammu and Kashmir.

The Series of MSME started with Haryana, as Haryana's industrial ecosystem thrives on the back of 9.7 lakh MSMEs which is employing 19.06 lakh people. The major MSME footprint present in the State includes sectors like automobile, food & beverages, textiles, engineering, and metals sector. The manufacturing MSME spectrum in the state comprises of both state-of-the-art medium enterprises as well as a large number of traditional micro and small enterprises.

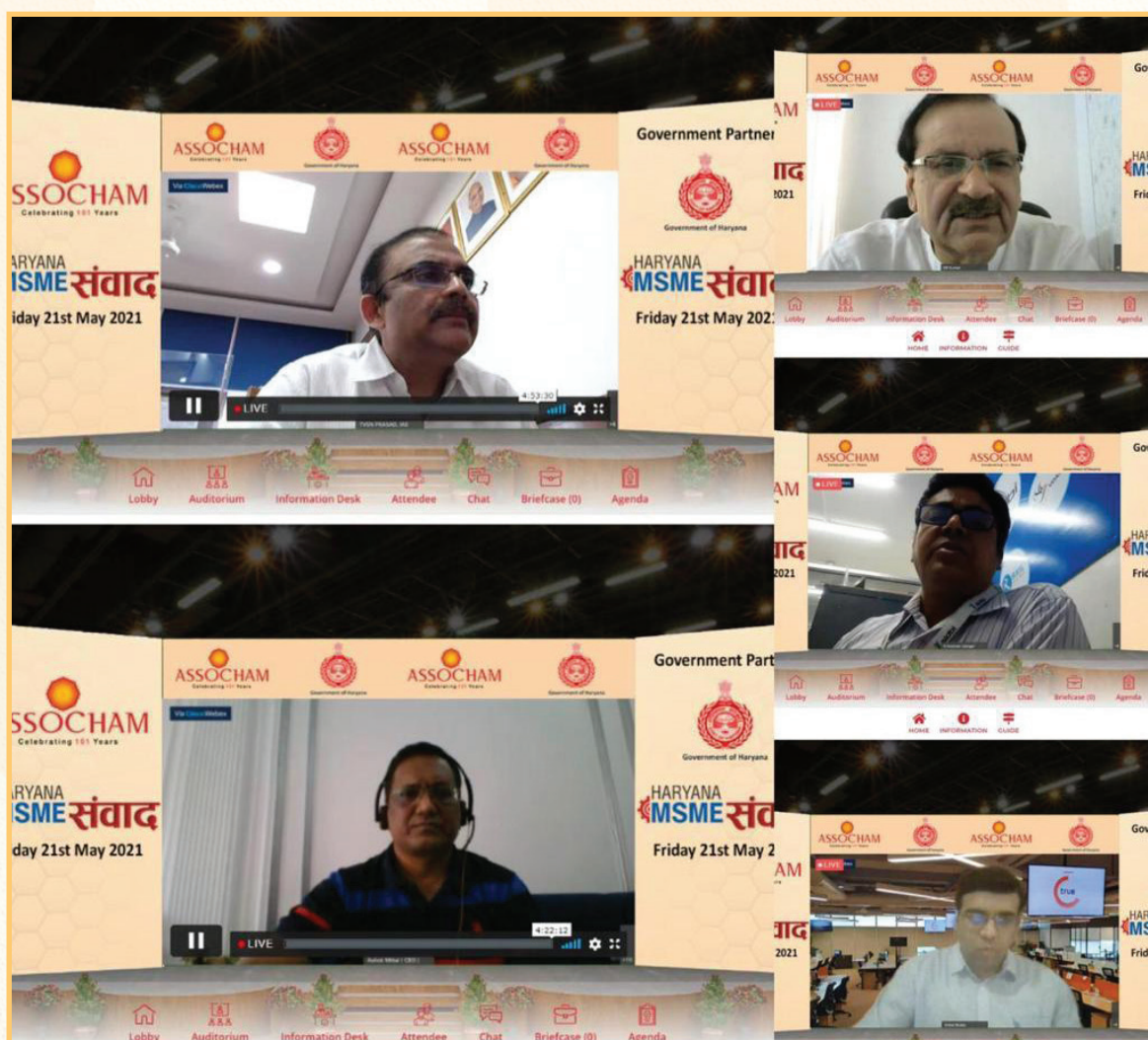
