As per the Road Accident Report for 2019 endorsed by the Ministry of Road Transport & Highways (MoRTH), 4,49,002 accidents occurred in the country during 2019, leading to 1,51,113 deaths and 4,51,361 injuries. In the past one decade, over 1 million people have lost their lives in road crashes. Consequently, this has led to unimaginable miseries to affected families and dented the Indian GDP by over 3 percent.

Safer Mobility with innovations and adoption of emerging technologies has always been key agenda for all stakeholders. World Economic Forum has also initiated the Road Safety 2.0 initiative in India.

Safer and sustainable mobility is utmost important for People, Planet and Prosperity to achieve the goal of safe road ecosystem. The need of the hour is paradigm shift from 4Es to 6Es, i.e. Education, Engineering, Enforcement, Emergency, Environment and Encouragement for better implementation of road safety norms with sustainability.
